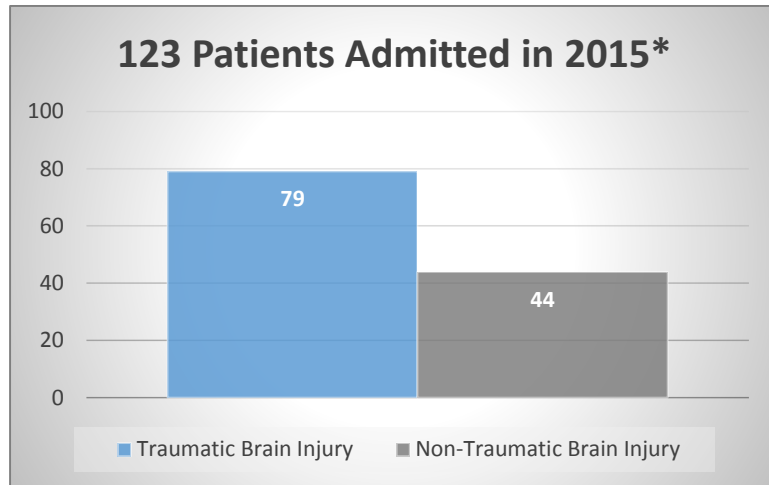


Santa Clara Valley Medical Center Brain Injury Program



How satisfied were our patients with their care?

- Over 95.9% of our patients rated their care as good to excellent.¹
- 92% of our patients would recommend our hospital to their friend and family.²

Where did our patients get discharged to?

- 86% of our patients were discharged to a home setting compared to a national average of only 75%.³
- Only 2% of our patients were discharged to a skilled nursing facility compared to the national average of 12%.³

How complex are the patients we treat medically?

- Based on case mix index, a measurement of the complexity of the medical needs, our patients were nearly 13.7% more medically complex than the national average.³

Who are our patients?

- The average age for patients with traumatic brain injury was 42 years old and the average age for patients with non traumatic brain injury is 50, with an overall average patient age of 45.³
- We serve adolescents starting at age 14 with an individualized, developmentally appropriate plan of care.
- 69% of the patients were male and 31% were female.³
- Patients stayed an average of 18 days in the hospital.³

Quality of Life:

- 97.6% of our patients agree that the rehab program prepared them for going home.¹
